

MUSD STAFF CLOSE CONTACTS

Steps to take when a close contact tests positive for COVID-19

UNVACCINATED

ASYMPTOMATIC PERSON

- Quarantine for 10-days from exposure.
- Self-monitor for symptoms* for 10-days from exposure date.
- Recommend test after **Day 5**.
- If positive, isolate for 10-days from test date or symptom onset (if symptomatic).
- If positive, test, contact trace for additional exposure starting 2-days prior to symptom onset.

POSITIVE CASE

Full at-home isolation for 10 days from symptom start or positive test regardless of positive case's vaccination or mask-wearing status.

VACCINATED

ASYMPTOMATIC PERSON

- No quarantine unless symptoms develop.
- If symptoms develop, quarantine and get tested for COVID-19.
- Recommend test after **Day 5**.
- If positive, isolate for 10-days from test date or symptom onset (if symptomatic).
- If positive, test, contact trace for additional exposure starting 2-days prior to symptom onset.

If you were in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 and test positive, then you should be at-home in isolation for 10-days from when you received a positive test or symptoms start. This is regardless of vaccination or mask-wearing.

***What is close contact? It's when you are within 6 feet for 15 cumulative minutes within a 24-hour period of someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.**
